➤ How to come ?

By Public transport:

- SUBWAY

- line **6** - **Glacière** station

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

- BUS

- line **216** (OrlyBus) - **Dareau - Saint Jacques** station -
- line **21** - **Glacière - Auguste Blanqui** station -

Arriving by PLANE:

- FROM ORLY AIRPORT:

From 5:45 am to 11:30 pm, the Orlybus will take you to Denfert-Rochereau. At Denfert-Rochereau, take the subway (line 6 - direction Nation) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 50 minutes by Orly bus for 8€ and 50€ by taxi.

- FROM ROISSY CHARLES DE GAULLE AIRPORT:

Get the RER line B direction ROBINSON-St Rémy les Chevreuses until Denfert-Rochereau Station. At Denfert-Rochereau, take the subway (line 6 - direction Nation) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 50 minutes and cost approximately 10€ by subway and 50€ by taxi.

Arriving by TRAIN

- FROM GARE MONTPARNASSE STATION (TGV)

Get the subway (line 6 - direction Nation) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 10 minutes and cost approximately 1,40€ by subway and 5€ by taxi.

- FROM GARE DE LYON STATION

Get the subway (line 14 - direction Olympiades) until Bercy station. At Bercy, take the subway (line 6 - direction Charles de Gaulle - Etoile) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 20 minutes and cost approximately 1,40€ by subway and 10€ by taxi.

- FROM GARE DU NORD STATION (EUROSTAR / THALYS)

Get the Regional Express Train (line B - direction Robinson - St Remy Les Chevreuses) until Denfert-Rochereau. It will take

about 10 minutes, and approximately cost 1.40 euros. At Denfert-Rochereau, take the subway (line 6 - direction Nation) until Glaciere station...

... or walk down the boulevard Saint Jacques (about 10 minutes), the hotel will be on your right.

By taxi, the journey will take about 20 minutes, and approximately cost 20 euros.

- FROM GARE ST-LAZARE STATION

Get the subway (line 13 - direction Châtillon-Montrouge) until Montparnasse station.

Get the subway (line 6 - direction Nation) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 30 minutes and cost approximately 1,40€ by subway and 15€ by taxi.

- FROM GARE DE L'EST STATION

Get the subway (line 5 - direction Place d'Italie) until the end of the line (Place d'Italie). At Place d'Italie, take the subway (line 6 - direction Charles de Gaulle - Etoile) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 30 minutes and cost approximately 1,40€ by subway and 15€ by taxi.

- FROM GARE D'AUSTERLITZ STATION

Get the subway (line 5 - direction Place d'Italie) until the end of the line (Place d'Italie). At Place d'Italie, take the subway (line 6 - direction Charles de Gaulle - Etoile) until Glacière station.

When you exit the subway station walk up the street for approximately 150 feet. The hotel is on the left side of the street.

It will take about 10 minutes and cost approximately 1,40€ by subway and 8€ by taxi.
